Advice on self-isolation

We understand that the current situation will be a concern to many of you. Current UK Government advice is to stay at home for 7 days if you have either:

- A high temperature
- A new continuous cough

You should also do the following:

- hand-washing for at least 20 seconds using soap and water, and use hand sanitizer gel if soap and water is not available
- cover mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough and sneeze
- bin used tissues and wash your hands immediately afterwards
- do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth
